Third Sunday of Ordinary Time

The theme at the center of this Sunday's liturgy is mission: the missions of Jonah, of Paul and of Jesus. This Sunday also coincides with the feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul the Apostle who is the model of the missionary. The celebration is orientated toward the awareness of the mission, of the place it should occupy, and how it is realized. We are all partners in mission, united with one another in proclaiming the Gospel. The Lord has placed in our hearts the desire to share together his word, his body, his blood. Thus He restores in us the strength we need to carry out the mission he entrusts to us. In that sense we are already fisherman. We carry out the mission when we bear witness to the presence of Christ in our lives and encourage others to do the same. In our families and in our work and social environment we carry out the mission.

Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

La misión es el tema principal de la liturgia de este domingo: la misión de Jonás, de Pablo y de Jesús.
