Psalm 86:5-6

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The Biblical texts of today invite us to celebrate God as being full of humanity and having pity on us. When we affirm that God has pity upon us, we do not mean that he considers us as lamentable, useless beings. The expression rather means that God is touched by our situation and spontaneously comes to help us. Facing a crowd that had not eaten for three days, Jesus feels pity for all these people (Mark 8, 2). Then he gives them food. At seeing a widow who was carrying the body of her son to be buried, "Jesus felt sorry for her," and brought her son back to life (Luke 7, 13). We must contemplate and celebrate God, the Bible tells us, as being human and compassionate. In doing so, we must remember that, created in the image of God and his own likeness (Genesis 1:26) we must be his imitators. "You must be perfect, as your heavenly father is perfect," Jesus says. (Matthew 5, 48)

Decimosexto To Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

El texto Bíblico de hoy nos invita a celebrar a Dios lleno de humanidad y teniendo piedad para todos. Esto no quiere decir que Dios nos considera como personas inútiles. La manifestación de piedad quiere decir que Dios es tocado por nuestra situación y viene voluntariamente a nuestra ayuda. Dios siente compasión por esta gente pues hace tres días que están conmigo y no tienen nada para comer. (Mateo 8,2) Y después le da de comer. Viendo a una viuda que llevaba el cuerpo de su único hijo para enterrarlo, "Jesús se compadeció de ella," y mando al hijo a levantarse (Lucas 7,13). La biblia nos manda contemplar y celebrar a Dios como un ser humano y compasivo. Al hacer esto nos recordamos que fuimos hechos en su imagen y semejanza (Génesis 1:26) y debemos imitarlos. "Por su parte, sean ustedes perfectos como el Padre de ustedes que es que esta en el Cielo," dijo Jesús. (Mateo 5,48)

Seizième dimanche du temps ordinaire

Les textes bibliques d'aujourd'hui nous invitent à célébrer un Dieu plein d'humanité qui a pitié de nous. Quand nous affirmons que Dieu a pitié de nous, nous ne voulons pas dire que Dieu nous considère comme des êtres lamentables, minables. L'expression signifie plutôt que Dieu est ému devant notre situation et qu'il vient spontanément à notre aide. Devant une foule qui n'avait pas mangé depuis trois jours, Jésus dit: "J'ai pitié de cette foule." (Marc 8, 2). Et il lui donna à manger. En présence d'une veuve qui portait le cadavre de son fils pour être inhumé, Jésus "fut saisi de pitié pour elle", et il ramena son fils à la vie" (Luc 7, 13). Nous devons certes contempler et célébrer ce Dieu que la Bible nous montre aujourd'hui si humain, si compatissant. En le faisant, nous nous rappellerons que, créés à l'image de Dieu et à sa ressemblance (Genèse 1. 26), nous avons à être ses imitateurs: "Soyez parfaits comme votre Père céleste est parfait", a dit Jésus. (Matthieu 5, 48).



Jesus spoke a parable. "The kingdom of heaven is like a mustard seed that a person took and sowed in a field. It is the smallest of seeds, yet when full grown it is the largest of plants. All those things Jesus spoke to the crowds in parables. He spoke to them only in parables, to fulfill what had been said through the prophet:

I will open my mouth in parables,

I will announce what has lain hidden from the foundation of the world.

FATHER DARBOUZE RETIRES

The following text about the retirement of Father Joseph Darbouze appeared in the July 10th edition of Catholic New York. We congratulate Father Darbouze on his retirement, thank him for his service to St. Gregory's and wish him a long and healthy life. Text follows:

Father Joseph Darbouze had been a senior priest at St. Raymond's in the Bronx since 2006. He was pastor of St. Gregory the Great, Manhattan, 1999-2005, and served there as administrator, 1994-1999, and parochial vicar, 1993-1994. He was parochial vicar of Holy Name of Jesus, 1980-1992, and St. Gregory the Great, both Manhattan. Born in Haiti, he was incardinated into the archdiocese in 1996.

ST. JAMES THE APOSTLE (SANTIAGO APOSTOL) - JULY 25

This coming Thursday, July 25, is the feast day of St. James the Apostle, one of the original twelve disciples of Christ. It is he, this simple Galilean fisherman, and his brother John, who are described in that most poignant Gospel scene, as mending their nets when Jesus, walking along the shore, calls to them. "And they immediately left the ship and their father [Zebedee], and followed him." (Matthew 4:22; also Mark 1:20) James must have been very close to Jesus, as he and his brother John and Peter are recorded in the Gospels as being present at the Transfiguration and the Agony in the Garden. We know from the Acts of the Apostles (12:1-2) of James's death in the year 44 A.D. at the hand of King Herod Agrippa I, grandson of Herod the Great, who tried to respond to the Jews' outrage over this new Christian sect. Some believe James's remains were transferred to Spain (where he is patron saint), but there is considerable dispute about this. The famous pilgrimage site of Santiago de Compostela in Spain honors this belief.

El fue vicario parroquial de Holy Name of Jesús, 1980-1992 y San Gregorio Magno, ambos en Manhattan. Nació en Haití, y recibió su incardinación a la arquidiócesis en 1996.
