Twenty-third Sunday in Ordinary Time

God is persevering. He unceasingly invites the sinner to pick himself up and turn to him. Through Jesus his Son, always present, he makes of his Church a family where each member has concern for one another. As a Church we are even so called upon to be in communion with one another. Often our parishes or our communities are places where we do pray alongside each other. But we do not truly know each other. We must admit, moreover, that in our present "mind your own business" society, the practice of brotherly or sisterly criticism is not the preferred approach for leading back a brother or sister who has strayed. Jesus' attitude of mercy shown to sinners would perhaps be a more effective method. One sees Jesus sharing table with sinners. He eats with publicans. Was not Matthew, who was called to become an apostle, also a publican? We are not called necessarily to make up for wrongs of the past, but rather to create in the present an atmosphere of love and pardon.

Again, amen, I say to you, if two of you agree on earth about anything for which they are to pray, it shall be granted to them by my heavenly Father. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them."

2nd COLL'CTN. NEXT SUNDAY SUPPORTS SEMINARY

A second collection will be taken at all masses next Sunday, Sept. 14, to support the Archdiocesan Seminary (St. Joseph's) in Dunwoodie, NY. This year, the Seminary celebrates its 118th year of existence, training the future priests of the Archdiocese. Please be generous next Sunday in supporting this very worthy cause.

SUN., SEPT. 21—WE CELEBRATE ST. GREGORY

Our Parish's custom is to celebrate the feast day of our patron saint, Gregory the Great, (which occurred on Sept. 3) instead on a later Sunday in September--this year on Sept. 21. On that day, we will hold here a special celebratory mass, in three languages, starting at 11:30 a.m., and there will not be the usual 10:00 a.m. Spanish mass, nor the 1:00 p.m. French mass. The 5:30 p.m. vigil mass on Saturday and the 8:00 a.m. mass on Sunday are not affected by the patron saint mass. Remember that this year, we are trying to make the collection for our patron saint's day into a special collection for the benefit of the whole Parish—like the Easter and Christmas collections on which we rely so heavily. So please consider placing in the collection basket, on Sept. 20 or 21 (whichever mass you attend), two or three times more money than you usually would give. It's a way to honor the special greatness of our Parish and our patron saint and to help to make up for low Summer collections. (There is no special envelope for this.)

WALK FOR THE POOR"-- SAT., SEPT. 20

By now, just about every parishioner should be aware that the annual fund-raising St. Vincent de Paul Society's "Friends of the Poor Walk" will take place on Saturday, Sept. 20, and that St. Gregory's is the host parish this year. That means that the two-mile walk, which begins on the steps of St. Patrick's Cathedral, will end here for 12:00 noon mass followed by a free light luncheon downstairs.
